Big Lake

Big Lake, the largest lake near Edmonton is protected as part of the Lois Hole Centennial Provincial Park. The lake is home to over 200 different bird species, including the beloved Kinglet. You can kayak on the lake, fish along the shore and up the river, or hop on the Red Willow Trail System for an invigorating hike or bike ride.

Environmental Reserve

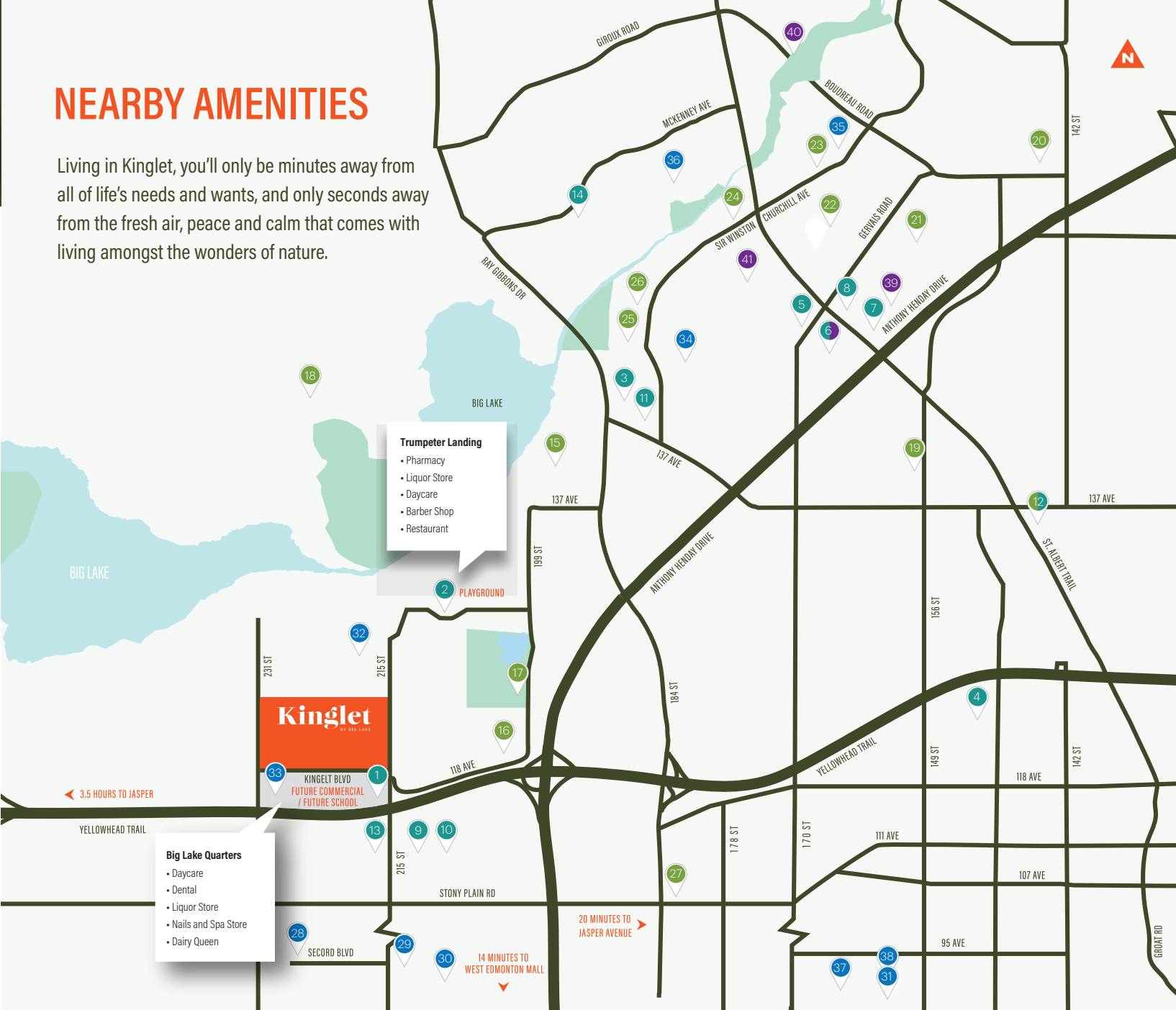
Preserving nature is just as important as appreciating it. Kinglet backs onto 60 acres of protected Environmental Reserve, where native wetlands and wild grasses support local wildlife and echo the natural beauty of Big Lake—preserving nature while connecting the community to it.

Lois Hole Provincial Park

Connect deeply with nature and spend afternoons exploring the 1,800 hectares of Lois Hole Centennial Provincial Park, just beyond the Trumpeter community. Walk along the boardwalk, try to spot some of the 235 diverse bird species in the area and head up to the wildlife viewing decks to spot beavers, deer, moose and more.

Kinglet by Big Lake offers endless opportunities for you to connect and unwind in your own natural habitat. Looking for information to help you get settled? You'll find answers here to some of our frequently asked questions.

If what you want to know isn't covered below, please contact your sales representative, and they'll be happy to help you find what you need!

What options do I have nearby for groceries, shopping and services?

You'll find familiar retail chains, boutique shops and even an outdoor farmers' market all within 15 minutes of your home in Kinglet.

- **Tim Hortons and Shell gas station – 2 minutes**
- Gas up and grab a bite, just a few minutes south on Winterburn Road.
- **The Enjoy Centre – 10 minutes**
- This unique mixed-use retail space houses a bakery, food market, premium liquor store, bistro and café, plus a greenhouse and garden centre.
- **Grocery stores – 10 minutes**
- Superstore, Save-On-Foods and Safeway are all within 1km of each other, just off Anthony Henday Drive and St. Albert Trail.
- **Costco – 10-15 minutes**
- The Yellowhead location is about 10 minutes east of Kinglet, and the Winterburn location is about 15 minutes south, so you can go where it's most convenient.
- **Downtown St. Albert/Perron District – 14 minutes**
- Every Saturday during the summer, downtown St. Albert hosts the largest outdoor farmers' market in Western Canada.

Will there be any commercial amenities within Kinglet?

There is no commercial development planned for inside the community of Kinglet by Big Lake so that you can enjoy a peaceful residential neighbourhood with plenty of commercial amenities nearby

How close is Kinglet to other amenities in Edmonton and St. Albert?

Kinglet's quick connections to Yellowhead Trail and Anthony Henday Drive make it easy to get to nearby amenities, as well as attractions a bit further away. As a result, you're only about 15 minutes away from finding almost anything you need.

- **West Edmonton Mall – 15 minutes**
- **Currents of Windermere – 20 minutes**
- **Downtown Edmonton – 22 minutes**
- **Edmonton International Airport – 30 minutes**

Are there any dog parks nearby?

Yes! The nearest off-leash dog park is Lacombe Lake Dog Park located just off Ray Gibbons Drive in St. Albert, so it's easy to take your furry friends out for some playtime in the fresh air. Lose the leash, and let Fido run wild!

Where will my kids be going to school?

The current designated schools for Kinglet, which include public and Catholic options, are just a short trip from home. Please confirm with the school board's website for the most up to date information on designated schools:

- **Public schools serving Kinglet**
 - Winterburn School (K-6) – 8 minutes
 - Michael Phair School (7-9) – 9 minutes
 - Jasper Place School (10-12) – 15 minutes
- **Catholic schools serving Kinglet**
 - Annunciation Catholic Elementary School – 15 minutes
 - St. Thomas More Catholic Junior High School – 20 minutes
 - St. Francis Xavier High School – 20 minutes

How big will Kinglet be when complete?

There are 1,311 single family lots and 8.8 acres to accommodate multifamily homes in Kinglet by Big Lake.

Does Kinglet have a Homeowner Association (HOA)?

Anthem decided the community will work well without the use of an HOA.

When will Kinglet be completed?

The last stages of community development should be complete in 2031, with final lot sales anticipated in 2032 and most home construction finished by around 2033.

Who maintains the neighbourhood streets, parks and green spaces?

Anthem is in charge of neighbourhood maintenance until community construction, and Final Acceptance Certificates (FAC) are complete. After that, Anthem will turn things over to the City of Edmonton, who will maintain streets and park spaces, along with providing other essential municipal services for Kinglet.

Does my property come with any trees or landscaping?

Anthem provides the residents with a canvas to complete the landscaping around their home, with guidance from a set of professionally designed architectural guidelines. The neighbourhood landscaping includes beautiful boulevard trees throughout Kinglet by Big Lake. There are also natural environmental reserve spaces around the community, which include mature trees and other types of greenery for you to enjoy.
